

Add to the end of 2nd section: "nor shall they be interested directly or indirectly, in any contract in which the county, may be interested."

Sub-section 2, line 89, after "March," insert "or as soon as may be practicable."

In the last section, insert after the word "effect," in 1st line "except as to the time of election."

Which were adopted.

The Senate Joint Resolution in relation to the Great Seal of the State,

Being on second reading,

Mr. Steiner submitted the following amendment:

"That the Governor of the State, is hereby authorized to have the Great Seal of the State, so altered as to make it conform to the Arms of Lord Baltimore, as represented on the title-page of Bacon's Laws of Maryland, printed 1765, in Annapolis, by Jonas Green.

Which was adopted.

Said Resolution was then read the second time, as amended, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
