The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 15 of Article XXIX. of the Code of Public General Laws, and re-enact the same with the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add to the end of section 1, line 7, "provided that no verdict or award of a jury, or inquisition or condemnation, shall carry interest until the property condemned shall be actually taken possession of by the party in whose favor said verdict or award may have been rendered."
