inconsistent with this act, and the law of the land, be and the same are hereby made good and valid in law, and the CHAP 95. lands and tenements conveyed to the said committee in eighteen hundred and twenty four, be and the same are hereby vested in the corporation mentioned in the second clause of this act, and their successors, forever.

## CHAPTER 95.

A Further Supplement to the act to provide for the Passed Feb 14. Public Instruction of Youth in Primary Schools in Anne-Arundel County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Tax in Anna-Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, polis to be colthe collector of city taxes in the city of Annapolis, for the lected by city time being, shall be and he is hereby made, ex officio, col-collector lector of primary school taxes in and for the district in which the city of Annapolis is or may be situated; and every primary school tax, which may hereafter be voted to be levied on the property in said district, shall be and is hereby made collectable by the collector of city taxes who may be in office at the time at which such tax shall be collectable.

And be it enacted, That in case of the resig-Proceedings nation, refusal to serve, or other disqualification or disabi in case of dislity of the present collector of primary school taxes for ability of presaid district, it shall be the duty of the collector of city sent collector taxes in said city, to be appointed for the present year, to collect the primary school taxes in said district which have been voted to be collected in the present year.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the collector of city Rights and retaxes in said city, in relation to the primary school taxes sponsibilities to be collected by him, shall have all the rights, and be subject to all duties and responsibilities, which are or may be incident to the office of collector of primary school taxes.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the condition of the Bond bond to be given by the collector of city taxes in said city. shall be, that he shall well and faithfully exercise the office of collector according to law; and on any breach of said condition, in relation to the collection or payment of primary school taxes, an action or actions may be prosecuted on said bond, for the use of the trustees of the primary
