## CHAPTER 115.

Passed Feb 18. An Act for the relief of Caleb Stuart and Richard Mace, of Anne-Arundel County.

Levy authorised.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That the commissioners for Anne-Arundel county be and
they are hereby authorised and directed, to levy upon the
assessable property of said county the sum of one hundred
dollars for the benefit of Caleb Stuart and Richard Mace,
of said county, and the collector of said county is hereby
authorised and directed to collect and pay over to the said
Caleb Stuart and Richard Mace, or their order respectively, the sum of fifty dollars each, any law to the contrary
notwithstanding.
