CHAPTER 16.

*An Act to provide for the erection of a Bridge over Antietam Creek, at or near Hager's Mill in Washington County.* Passed Jan. 25

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That the commissioners of Washington county be and they are hereby authorised and required, if in their opinion they shall deem the same necessary and proper, to cause to be erected over Antietam creek, on the public road leading from Hager's-Town, in said county, to Frederick county, by the way of Orr's Gass, a substantial stone, or wooden and stone bridge, upon such plan, terms and conditions, and under such superintendance, as they may deem most conducive to the public interest, and that they be and are hereby authorised and required, to levy on the assessable property of said county, in two or more equal annual levies, such sum or sums of money as they shall deem necessary to defray all expenses incurred in and about the erection of said bridge.
