Passed Feb 11. An Act for the relief of Thomas Murphey, of Queen-Anne's County.

Judges of county court That the judges of Queen-Anne's county court, be and examine act they are hereby authorised and empowered, to revise and examine the account of Thomas Murphey, clerk of said county, presented to levy court in the year eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, and should they find upon examination, that improper and illegal deductions and abatements have been made therefrom, to certify the amount thereof to the present levy court of said county, whose duty it shall be to levy the same on the assessable property of said county, for the use of the said Thomas Murphey, to be collected as other county charges are.
