## CHAPTER 161.

*An Act to authorise and empower Commissioners to open and extend the breadth of an Alley in Westminster, in Frederick County.* Passed Feb 23.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Philip Jones, Jacob Yangling, Isaac Shriver, William Shipley, Junior, and Jacob Grove, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to view an alley running from the main-street of the town of Westminster, near David Keifer's tavern, being the same that was heretofore laid out by an act of assembly passed December session eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter one hundred and thirteen, and if in their opinion the public convenience would thereby be promoted, they are hereby authorised and empowered to open and extend the breadth of said alley, in addition to its present width, fourteen feet on the main street of said town, thence with a straight line to the north corner of the late Jacob Sherman's land. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That before the said commissioners proceed to discharge of the duties herein directed, they shall give public notice to all persons concerned, by not less than three advertisements, set up at the most public places in said town, and be duly qualified according to law. Notice to be

Sec. 3 *And be it enacted*, That if in the opinion of said commissioners, or a majority of them, the public convenience would thereby be promoted by extending the breadth of said alley, that then they shall award whatever damages, (if any) the representatives of Jacob Sherman will thereby sustain, which sum shall be paid by the aforesaid Damages
