Sec 7. And be it enacted. That the commissioners aforesaid shall have power to fill any vacancy or vacancies CHAP 161. in the board of trustees which may from time to time happen from any cause whatever.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That this act shall not be when to be in in operation until on the first day of January eighteen hun-operation

dred and thirty two.

Sec 9. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts, Repeal inconsistent with, or repugnant to, the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 161.

An Act to authorise and empower Commissioners to Passed Feb 23. open and extend the breadth of an Alley in Westminster, in Frederick County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of May Maryland, That Philip Jones, Jacob Yingting, Isaac Shri-tended ver, William Shipley, Junior, and Jacob Grove, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to view an alley running from the main-street of the town of Westminster, near David Keifer's tavern, being the same that was heretofore laid out by an act of assembly passed December session eighteen hundred and twentv-six, chanter one hundred and thirteen, and if in their opinion the public convenience would thereby be promoted, they are hereby authorised and empowered to open and extend the breadth of said alley, in addition to its present width, fourteen feet on the main street of said town, thence with a straight line to the north corner of the late Jacob Sherman's land.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That before the said com- Notice to be missioners proceed to discharge of the duties herein di-given rected, they shall give public notice to all persons concerned, by not less than three advertisements, set up at the most public places in said town, and be duly qualified according to law.

Sec. 3 And be it enacted, That if in the opinion of said Damages commissioners, or a majority of them, the public convenience would thereby be promoted by extending the breadth of said alley, that then they shall award whatever damages, (if any) the representatives of Jacob Sherman will thereby sustain, which sum shall be paid by the aforesaid
