dition to the sum he now receives. In Charles county, for Henry Proctor, thirty dollars, (payable to Theodore CHAP. 164. Mudd, or order,) payable to themselves, or their orders respectively, or to such person or persons as the said levy courts or county commissioners may direct.

CHAPTER 163.

An Act for the relief of Peter Johnson, of the City of Passed Feb 22.

Bultimore.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Benefit of acts That the commissioners of insolvent debtors for the city extended to and county of Baltimore, be and they are hereby authorishim ed and empowered, to grant to Peter Johnson, of the city of Baltimore, the benefit of the several acts of assembly passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; Provided, the said Peter Johnson, shall in all respects, (except that of proving residence,) comply with the requisitions of said acts of assembly, and that he satisfy the said commissioners that he did not come into this state with the view of obtaining the benefit of the said insolvent laws.

CHAPTER 164.

An Additional Supplement to an act, entitled, An act Passed Feb 23 for Quieting Possessions, Enrolling Conveyances, and securing the Estates of Purchasers.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Deeds for con-Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, veying interact of the conveyance of any interest or estate in before any lands, tenements or hereditaments, lying in this state, being judge, act of executed and acknowledged within the United States, or be effectual any territory thereof, before any judge of a court of law and of record, of the state or territory in which such person or persons may be at the time, or before any judge of any of the United States courts, shall be good and effectual for the purpose or purposes therein mentioned; Provid-proviso, ed, that the acknowledgment shall be certified or endors-
