Passed Feb 17 A Resolution in favour of John Rigney, of Frederick County.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore be and he is hereby authorised and directed, to pay to John Rigney, esquire, late sheriff of Frederick county, out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of forty-one dollars and ninety-six cents.

Passed Feb 18 A Resolution in favour of the Trustees of the Abingdon Academy, in Harford County.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore be, and he hereby is directed, to pay to the trustees of the Abingdon Academy, in Harford county, or to their order, the sum of three hundred dollars, on the first Monday of October annually, as a donation to said academy, provided that the said trustees shall previously have conveyed and secured to the state, for the use of the said school, the entire estate and effects of the institution, derived under the act of December session eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, chapter thirty-seven, or otherwise; and, in that event, one hundred dollars, out of the said donation, to be applied towards the extinguishment of the debts due on account of the corporation, and for the completion of the buildings, and the purchase of the necessary furniture and implements.
