ROADS.

A road to be laid out and opened commencing at or near Bohemia Ferry, in Cecil county, running thence across Bohemia manor to Back creek, at or near Bohemia village, thence by a bridge across the said creek to Chesapeake city, thence in a northerly direction until it intersects the road leading from Warwick to Elkton, and commissioners to levy a sum of money for making the said road 45 43

Prescribing the powers and duties of the commissioners of Washington county, in regard to, 75 75

Commissioners appointed to lay out and open a road not exceeding thirty feet in width, commencing at the Liberty road in Baltimore county, at a stone standing between the lands of Israel Rinehart and Polatio Gorsuch, running on the most practicable route to Benjamin Gorsuch's tan-yard, to pass near the dwelling of Samuel Car, thence by the east end of a lane known by the name of the Pole Lane, then to intersect a road in Frederick county leading from Westminster to Liberty, at or near the lands of George Warfield, and to make out and return plats of the same to the clerks of Frederick and Baltimore county courts to be recorded 82 79

Commissioners appointed to survey, lay out, straighten and amend, the public road from John Barnes' tavern in said county, to the Burnt Mills, and thence to the cross roads near the house of Thomas Gittings, whenever they
