Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Parts of consti-Maryland, That all such parts of the fortieth, forty-first tution repealand forty-seventh articles of the constitution and form of ed. government of this state, and all and every part of the said constitution and form of government which relates to the register of wills or clerks of county courts in this state, be and the same are hereby abolished, abrogated, annulled and made void.

Sec. 2.
