

county to perform in virtue of this act, without fee or reward; and he shall keep, in a well bound book or books to be provided for the purpose, fair and correct accounts and statements of the proceedings of the said court in relation to the proportion of the school fund to which the said county is, or may hereafter be entitled, exhibiting, in a particular manner, how the same has or may be appropriated and disposed of; which said book or books shall be kept open and accessible to the examination and inspection of the citizens of the county, and all other persons that may be interested or in any way concerned therein.

CHAP. 41.

Sec 7. *And be it enacted*, That from and after the passage of this act, the orphans court of said county shall fill all vacancies which may occur by death, resignation, or otherwise, in the board of the commissioners of the school fund of said county. Vacancies.

Sec. 8. *And be it enacted*, That any law inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed. Repeal.

CHAPTER 41.

An Act to authorise the recording of the Will of Christian Wyandt, late of Washington County. Passed Feb. 3.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the register of wills of Washington county shall be and he is hereby authorised and required, to transcribe and place upon record the last will and testament of Christian Wyandt, late of Washington county, deceased, as the same was copied and certified by the late register of wills of said county, under the seal of his office, on the seventh day of March eighteen hundred and twelve. Will to be placed on record.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the record made in obedience to this act, from the aforesaid certified copy, shall have the same force and effect to all intents and purposes as if it had been made at the proper time from the original will of the said Christian Wyandt. To be of force, &c.
