## CHAPTER 56.

Passed Feb. 8. An Act directing the manner of advertising Trespassing Estrays.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Estrays to be Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, advertised. when any person aggrieved shall take up as an estray, trespassing upon his enclosures, any horse, mare or gelding, it shall be the duty of such person to cause the description thereof, taken by a justice of the peace, to be published and continued three successive weeks in a newspaper, if any there be published in the county where such estray shall be taken up, if none be there published, then in such newspaper as the justice taking such description shall direct; and the said justice is hereby required to direct publication as aforesaid to be made in such newspaper as in his opinion has most extensive circulation in the county where any such estrays may be taken up.

Sec. 2. And he it enacted, That this act shall not be taken or construed to repeal any part of the existing laws of this state, except such as are inconsistent with the pro-

visions herein contained.
