See 4. And be it enacted, That the said Ann Matthews may, and she is hereby authorised to re-assume and use her maiden surname.

thews shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Ann.

CHAPTER 93.

Passed Feb 14. A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to incorporate the Trustees of The Muria Marthian Society of Baltimore, passed at December session 1828, chapter 154.

Style changed

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name and style of the society incorporated by the act to which this is a supplement, shall be and the same is hereby changed and altered to The Charitable Relief Society of Baltimore, by which name and style the said society shall hereafter be known, and shall and may exercise all the corporate powers, rights and privileges, granted to or vested in the said society by its original name and style, by the act to which this is a supplement, and enjoy, hold and use, all the property, estate and effects, acquired and now owned by said corporation; and the trustees of the said Maria Marthian Society now in office, shall be entitled to exercise and enjoy all the powers and privileges heretoforc vested in them, and the said corporation shall be answerable for all just claims, in the same manner, and as fully to all intents and purposes, as if the name and style thereof had not been changed or altered by this act.
