CHAPTER 90.

Passed Feb. 4,1832 A further supplement to an act, entitled, An act to authorise
the Governor and Council of Maryland, to appoint the
Inspectors of Flour for this state, passed at December session eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter one hundred
and seventy four.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, by the act to which this is a supplement, it is provided that an inspector of flour be appointed for the city of Frederick; and it appears that further provisions are necessary to enable the citizens of Frederick fully to enjoy the benefits of said inspection—Therefore,

Inspectors compensation. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, the inspector of flour appointed for the city of Frederick, shall have and receive of the owner or owners of flour by him inspected, the sum of one cent and a half, and no more, for each cask of flour that he shall inspect and brand, according to the rules and regulations existing in said city.

Limits of inspec-

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the inspection district of the inspector appointed for the city of Frederick, shall embrace the corporation limits of said city as now defined, and that all rules and regulations now in force in said city in regard to the inspection of flour, and not repealed or altered by this act, do and the same are hereby declared to extend to every part of the said inspection district: Provided, That nothing in said rules and regulations contained, shall be construed to authorise any inspector of flour to inspect the same in or at any mill within said district.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That no inspector of flour shall purchase directly or indirectly, any flour by him con-
