CHAPTER 21.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma- Commissioners to ryland, That all the citizens of Harford county, qualified to vote for delegates to the general assembly, and also, having the same qualifications as are, or shall be required, to entitle them to vote, for such delegates, shall, on the first Monday of October, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, and every three years thereafter, vote by ballot, for five persons, one of whom shall reside in each election district at the time of the election, and those five persons receiving the greatest number of legal votes and residing in each district as aforesaid, shall be declared duly elected commissioners of said county.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the clerk to the said comsioners shall attend in his office every Tuesday in the months of March, April, May, June, August, September, October and November, and at all other times, when required by any of the citizens of said county.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That all such part or parts of Repeal. the original act to which this is a supplement, which requires that each district shall elect one commissioner, be and the same is hereby repealed.
