CHAP 226.

*An act relating to the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company.* Passed Mar. 7, 1831

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That before any certificates of stock of the state shall be issued by the treasurer, by virtue of the act passed at the present session, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the promotion of internal improvement, the said treasurer shall call on the president and directors of the said company, to furnish, in writing, a full and fair statement of the amount of monies received by them, and the particular manner in which such monies have been appropriated, and unless such statement is furnished, under the oath of the president of said company, giving a full and specific account of such expenditure, the said stock shall not be issued, any thing in the said act contained, to the contrary notwithstanding; and the said treasurer shall also require of them, anterior to the issuing of the said stock, the assent in writing, of the said company, to furnish whenever called on by the state, such statement as may be required, of the actual expenditure of their funds and the condition of said company.

CHAPTER 226.

*A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the relief of the Poor of Caroline county.* Passed Mar. 7, 1832

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, that all vacancies that may take place in the present board of trustees of the poor in said county, either by death or removal out of the county, resignation, or becoming incapable to act as such, shall be filled and appointed by the executive of this state.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all such parts of the act, to which this is a further additional supplement, that are repugnant to or inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.
