

every subsequent month, deposit in such incorporated bank as the said school commissioners shall designate, to the credit of the school commissioners aforesaid, whatsoever money he shall collect as and for the school tax aforesaid, first deducting therefrom, the compensation allowed to him by the commissioners of the county, or the school commissioners aforesaid for collecting the same; and the said school commissioners shall have the same power after the day first above mentioned, to enforce the collection and secure the payment by the said collector, of all arrears of said school tax. that was previously possessed by the commissioners of said county.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the school commissioners aforesaid, shall either cause the tax which may be or has been levied for the year eighteen hundred and thirty-two, for the support and establishment of said schools in said district, by the commissioners of said county, to be collected; or they may, in their discretion, cause in lieu thereof a new assessment and levy to be made for the support of said schools, for the year eighteen hundred and thirty-two; and for the purpose of assessing the property and income subject to said tax, the said school commissioners shall employ, appoint, qualify and compensate an assessor, as often as they shall find one necessary, to assess the whole or any part of the property or income aforesaid; or to review, and with the approbation of said school commissioners, acting as commissioners of the tax, to correct or alter such parts of any of said assessments, as should be altered, when property has been sold or transferred, or when complaint is made that the assessment is unjust, and such complaint shall be found true, in whole or part; and every person who shall be appointed to assess or review the property or income in the said district, subject to said tax, or any part thereof, shall before he enters upon the duties of his appointment, solemnly swear or affirm, that he will discharge the duties confided to him as assessor under this act, without favor or prejudice, and to the best of his ability; and for the purpose of collecting the taxes levied for the support of said schools, the commissioners of said schools shall, from time to time, employ, appoint and compensate such collector or collectors as they shall think fit; and the same shall suspend or remove at their pleasure, and in order to secure the prompt and faithful performance of the duties of each of said collectors, the said school commissioners shall take from them respectively, such bond and security as the said commissioners shall think sufficient, which bond shall be conditioned for the performance of the duties confided to the collec-
