CHAPTER 38.

*An act to provide for the erection of a Bridge over Antietam Creek, on the road leading from Williamsport to Boonsborough, in Washington county.*

Passed Jan. 25, 1832

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Washington county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required, to cause to be erected, over Antietam creek, upon the best practicable site, at or near the old bridge, on the road leading from Williamsport to Boonsborough, a substantial stone bridge, upon such plan, terms and conditions, and under such superintendance as they may deem most conducive to the public interest, and that they be, and are hereby authorised and required, to levy on the assessable property of said county, in two equal annual levies, such sum or sums of money as they shall deem necessary to defray all expenses incurred in and about the erection of said bridge.

CHAPTER 39.

*An act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery and Frederick Counties.*

Passed Jan. 24, 1832

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Jacob Nichols, Patrick Murphy, of Montgomery county and John H. Simmons and A. H. Brown of Frederick county, be, and the same are hereby appointed commissioners to survey, lay out and open a road not exceeding thirty feet in width commencing at Barnesville, in Montgomery county, and to intersect by the most direct and practicable route to Bennets creek, on the north side at or near Tanneyhills Grist Mill, which is in Frederick county, and the said commissioners shall make out a plat of that part of the road through Frederick county, and return the same to the clerk
