Act of 1824, chap-189, extended to Baltimore county. Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the provisions of the act, entitled, An act relating to justices of the peace in the city of Baltimore, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-four, chapter one hundred and eighty-nine, be and they are hereby extended and declared to apply to the justices of the peace in for Baltimore county, out of the limits of said city; Provided however, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to confer in the premises, on said justices, any jurisdiction exclusive of Baltimore county court; and the provisions of the acts of assembly, relating to writs of certiorari for judgments of the justices of the peace in and for the city of Baltimore, are hereby extended to judgments rendered by justices of the peace in and for Baltimore county aforesaid, out of the limits of the city.

Proviso.

Proceedings under decisions (of board of examiners of piots directed. Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That every such informal, or defective judgment or decision as aforesaid, of the aforesaid board of examiners of pilots, shall have the effect and be sustainable as aforesaid, before any justice of the peace when proceeded on before him; and every such case shall be proceeded with and adjudged by him as is herein directed, in respect of the county court in such behalf.

Operation of 1st section limited to Baltimore county.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the first section of this act, be and the same is hereby declared to apply only to Baltimore county court.

PassedMar.12,1832 An act to establish a Bank, and incorporate a company, under the name of the Commercial Bank of Millington, in Kent County.

Bank established.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maland, That a bank, to be called and known by the name of the Commercial Bank of Millington, in Kent county, and that all persons who may become stockholders in the Commercial Bank of Millington are hereby made a corporation and body politic, under the name and style of the Commercial Bank of Millington, and by that name shall be, and are hereby made capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, defend and be defended, in any court of record, or any other place whatever,
