No. 68.

Passed Mar. 14, 1832 Resolution in favor of Samuel LeCompt, of Dorchester County.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to Samuel Lecompt, or to his order, the sum of forty-six dollars, and twenty cents, being the amount of his account for provisions, furnished to the militia, in Dorchester county, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty.

No. 69.

Passed Mar. 6, 1832 Resolution in favor of Elizabeth Donnelly.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to Elizabeth Donnelly, of Frederick county, widow of Patrick Donnelly, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during widowhood, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during said war.

Passed Mar. 6, 1832 Resolution in favor of Sarah White of Montgomery county, widow of Samuel B. White, a Soldier of the Revolutionary war.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to Sarah White, of Montgomery county, widow of Samuel B. White, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during widowhood, in half yearly payments a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during said war. . .
