Resolution in favour of Magdalena Coffroth.

Passed Feb. 29, 1832

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Magdalene Coffroth, of Washington county, widow of Conrod Coffroth, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during her widowhood, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, in consideration for the services rendered by her husband during said war.

No. 82.

Resolution in favour of Claudius Legrande.

Passed Mar. 9, 1832

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to Claudius Legrande, or to his order, the sum of thirty-one dollars and sixty-seven cents, being the sum due to Charles Croxall, a revolutionary pensioner, at the time of his death.

No. 83.

Resolution in favour of John Eisell.

Passed Mar. 9, 1832

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western shore pay to John Eisell, of Baltimore, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, during life, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, in consideration of his services during the revolutionary war.

Resolution in favour of Sarah Auld, of Talbot county.

Passed Mar. 9, 1832

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That treasurer of the western shore pay to Sarah Auld, of Talbot county, widow of Daniel Auld, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during widowhood, in half
