## RESOLUTIONS.

No. 89.

Passed Mar. 4, 1832 Resolution authorising the Executive to subscribe for copies of Index of Maryland Reports.

*Resolved*, That the executive of the state, be, and they are hereby authorised to subscribe for as many copies of the digested Index of the Maryland reports, prepared and to be published by Alexander Randall, as are now taken by the state, of the Maryland Reports.

No. 90.

Passed Mar. 28, 1832 Resolution in favor of Kitty Hood.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Kitty Hood, widow of James Hood, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to her order, during her widowhood in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a lieutenant, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during said war.

No. 91.

Passed Feb. 27, 1832 Resolution in favour of the Rev. Mr. Guest, and the Rev. Mr. Blanchard.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to the Reverend Mr. Guest, chaplain of the house of delegates, and to the Reverend Mr. Blanchard, chaplain of the senate, or their respective orders, each, the sum of one hundred dollars, as compensation for their services during the present session.

Passed Mar. 8, 1832 Resolution in favour of Captain Henry Hurt.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the armorer at Annapolis, be, and he is hereby required to de-
