Resolution in favor of Andrew Slicer and John Quynn.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Andrew Slicer, messenger of the senate; and John Quynn, door keeper of the house of delegates, the sum of sixty dollars each, for taking care of their respective rooms and furniture, during the recess of the legislature.

Resolution in favor of Jeremiah Hughes.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Jeremiah Hughes, or order, one hundred and forty-one dollars and thirty-one cents for so much due to him for printing of this house since the close of the journal of accounts.
