### CHAPTER 116.

*An act to divorce Mary E. Lewis of the city of Baltimore from her husband William W. Lewis.* Passed Mar. 2, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Mary E. Lewis of the city of Baltimore, be, and she is hereby divorced from bed, board, and mutual cohabitation with her husband William W. Lewis. Divorce

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said William W. Lewis, shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Mary E. Lewis, nor be entitled to any property or estate which she may hereafter acquire, nor shall she the said Mary E. Lewis, be entitled to any property or estate, which he may hereafter acquire. Liabilities annulled

### CHAPTER 117.

*An act to divorce Mary Tyson of Cecil county from her husband Joseph Tyson.* Passed Mar. 2, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Mary Tyson of Cecil county, be, and she is hereby divorced from bed, board and mutual cohabitation with her husband Joseph Tyson. Divorce

\* SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Joseph Tyson, shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Mary Tyson, nor be entitled to any property or estate which she may hereafter acquire, nor shall the said Mary Tyson be entitled to any property or estate which he may hereafter acquire. Liabilities annulled
