

report the amount to the levy court of Worcester county, who are hereby authorised and required to levy the same upon the assessable property of said county, to be paid by the collector to the builder or builders of said wharf or his or their order.

Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the justices of the levy court, for Worcester county, may, in their discretion, allow to each of the aforesaid commissioners, two dollars per day, and no more, for each day they may be necessarily employed in executing the duties imposed by this act.

CHAPTER 123.

*An act, entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act to establish State Warehouses, for the Inspection of Tobacco, in the City of Baltimore.* Passed Mar. 10, 1835

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful for any person or persons employed as clerks or labourers in the States Tobacco Inspection Warehouses in the city of Baltimore, to purchase or sell, or in any manner whatever to deal in the article of Tobacco.

Officers, &c. prohibited dealing in tobacco

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the several Inspectors of the State Warehouses to take care of all unpacked scrap Tobacco, which the owners may neglect or refuse to take away or dispose of, and to hold the same subject to the orders of the States Wharfinger; who is hereby directed to sell the same, and to place the nett proceeds in the hands of the Inspectors for the purpose of defraying in part the expenses of said Warehouse.
