A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to lay out and Passed Mar. 15, 1836 open a new Road in Frederick and Baltimore Counties. passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty two, chapter twenty three.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Baltimore county are hereby authorised and required to receive, examine, and audit the account of Alexander Gellis, and Greenbury A. Gellis and G. Shepleys accounts Shepley, two of the commissioners named in the act to which this is a supplement, for work done in surveying, locating, and opening the Road mentioned in said act, and to allow them the whole, or such part thereof as they may think just and proper; provided, the said account be proved and authenticated according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and the necessary sum to pay the same be levied and collected as provided for in said act.
