CHAPTER 139.

*A supplement to the act, entitled, an act to authorise the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company, to construct a lateral Rail Road to Westminster and for other purposes.*

Passed Mar. 22, 1835

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the time limited by the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, within which the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company were required to complete a branch Rail Road, as far as the Town of Westminster, be, and the same is hereby extended for the term of five years after the expiration of the time limited by the said act.

CHAPTER 140.

*An act to divorce Maranda Hyatt, of Montgomery County, from her husband Lloyd Hyatt.*

Passed Mar 14, 1835

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the marriage heretofore solemnized between Maranda Hyatt of Montgomery county and Lloyd Hyatt, be, and the same is hereby declared to be null and void, to all intents and purposes, and that the said Maranda Hyatt and Lloyd Hyatt, be, and they are divorced, a vinculo matrimonii.
