

through the buildings, orchard, garden or yard of any person or persons, without his, her or their consent.

CHAP. 149.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the aforesaid commissioners, or a majority of them, shall ascertain the amount of damages which any person or persons may sustain by the laying out and marking said lot of ground, which amount they shall return to the levy court of Worcester county, who are hereby authorised and directed to levy on the assessable property, of said county, a sufficient sum to cover all such damages, and pay the same to the person or persons entitled thereto.

Damages

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the aforesaid commissioners, after having as above prescribed laid out and marked said lot of ground, to offer the contract for building said wharf by advertisement, placed in at least five of the most conspicuous places in the neighbourhood, to the lowest and best bidder, who shall give bond in a penalty double the amount of the contract, with security, to be approved by the commissioners for the construction and completion of the said wharf in a durable and workmanlike manner.

Contract for constructing

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the aforesaid commissioners, or a majority of them, after contracting for the building and completion of said wharf, shall report the amount and terms of contract to the levy court of Worcester county, who are hereby authorised and required to levy the same upon the assessable property of said county, to be paid by the collector to the builder or builders of said wharf, or his or their order.

Report—levy directed

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That the justices of the peace of the levy court for Worcester county may, in their discretion, allow to each of the aforesaid commissioners two dollars per day, and no more, for each day they may be necessarily employed in executing the duties imposed by this act.

Compensation
