

CHAP. 182.

Their duty enlarged

to lessen the number of assessors authorised by the act to which this is a supplement, and cause the said lesser number to view in person all the lands in said county, so that they shall not be confined in their operations to election districts.

Section directed

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That should the Levy Court determine to lessen the number of assessors as hereinbefore authorised, they shall select the said lesser number from amongst those who were recommended and partially appointed under the act to which this is a supplement.

Conform to O. A.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of said Levy Court to conform to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, except so far as relates to those provisions wherein they are authorised by this supplement to exercise a discretion.

 CHAPTER 182.

Passed Mar 23, 1866 *An act for the relief of the Devises of William Hill, late of Prince George's County, deceased.*

Whereas

WHEREAS, William Hill, by his last will and testament, after devising to his son William B. Hill, his dwelling house with the improvements adjacent thereto, and the lands adjoining thereto, which were then held by the mother of the testator as a part of her dower in said lands, directed that the said William B. Hill's portion of the residue of the testator's real estate, should be laid off to him adjoining to said lands, and further directed that all his estate, real and personal, should be kept together for the support of his said wife, the maintainance and education of his children, and the payment of his debts; *And whereas*, the said testator, subject to the devises and directions in said will contained, directed a division of all his real estate, in equal shares among his children, the said William B. Hill, Clement Hill, Richard S. Hill, Eleanor Ann Hill, John Hill and Peggy Hill; *And whereas*, the said widow of the said testator has hitherto kept the said estate together, and has from the pro-
