owner or owners, to lay out, alter or change the course of the public road running through the farm of Benedict I. Semmes, of said county, in such manner, and in such place or places, as they may deem proper; *Provided*, such alterations or changes are not incompatible with the public interest and general convenience.

## CHAPTER 190.

An act to divorce Mary Hammer, of the City of Balti-Passed Mar.25,1836 more, from her husband James J. Hammer.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Divorce Maryland, That Mary Hammer, of the city of Baltimore, be, and she is hereby divorced a vinculo matrimonii, from her husband James J. Hammer.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said James J. Liabilities annulled Hammer shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Mary Hammer, nor be entitled to any property or estate, which she may hereafter acquire.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act inheritance shall be so construed as to effect the legitimacy of any children of the said James J. Hammer and Mary Hammer, or to prevent him, her, or them, from inheriting property, real or personal, in the same manner as if this act had not passed.

## CHAPTER 191.

An act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil County to Passed Mar. 25,1836levy a sum of money for the purpose of erecting additional buildings to the Alms house of said county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Levy authorised Maryland, That the commissioners of Cecil county, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered at their discretion to levy on the assessable property of said county in addition to the levy now authorised by law, a sum of money not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars for the purpose of erecting an additional buil-
