

CHAP. 210.No 14.Cox's townCompensation

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the additional election district shall be known as the fourteenth election district of Baltimore County, and the place of holding the polls thereof shall be at Cox's Town, and the place of holding the polls of that portion of the district not to be included in the fourteenth, shall be at Manchester.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the commissioners herein appointed, or to be appointed, shall be entitled to receive two dollars a day for their services, to be paid by the commissioners of Baltimore County.

CHAPTER 210.

Passed Mar. 22, 1836 An act to provide for the pay of Jurors, in Worcester County.

Levy for 1836-7

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Levy Court of Worcester county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to levy on the assessable property of said county, at the usual time of making the county levy, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-six, such sum of money as the said levy court may deem sufficient to defray the expenses which have been or may be incurred by the attendance of Jurymen, at Worcester County Court, during the year eighteen hundred and thirty-six, and eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

Annually hereafter in advance

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said levy court to levy as aforesaid, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, and annually thereafter, such sum of money as they may deem sufficient to pay the expenses which may be annually incurred by the attendance of Jurymen, at the Worcester County Court.

Collected

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the sum or sums of money directed to be levied by this act, shall be collected by the collector of Worcester county, as other county charges are now collected, and shall be accounted for by them as hereinafter directed.

Payment

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That from and after the first day of January, in the year eighteen hundred and
