SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That from and after the CHAP. 225. passage of this act, it shall be the duty of any justice of the peace, when he shall take a supersedeas, to read out the form to the party and his securieties, and shall enter on his docket, and endorse on said judgment the Endorsement-en following words, or words to the same effect; Superseded by A. B. and C. D. as the case may be, this day of months; the form being first read to the party and his securities, which said entry or endorsement, the said justice of the peace signing his name thereto, shall have the same force and . effect as if the same had been written out at length and signed by the justice.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That all acts inconsistent Repealing clause with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed; and in all cases of judgments rendered by justices of Directions for mathe peace, in the city of Baltimore, and by judgments of Baltimore county court, shall be signed by the said securities, in presence of said justices, or where any securities shall be incapable of writing, their marks in lieu of signatures shall be affixed, and shall be witnessed by some persons knowing the securities aforesaid, to be the persons they represent themselves, of which knowledge the said justices shall be satisfied, and shall so state on said entry.

CHAPTER 225.

An act to change the divisional lines between the Elec- Passed Mar 26, 1836 tion Districts, numbers one and six, in Washington County.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assem-Preamble bly, that it would greatly promote the convenience of the people, if the lines between the election districts. numbers one and six, in Washington county, were changed, so as to authorise the people to vote in said districts, in the same manner as they did before the passage of the act of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter ninety-two, and the act confirming the same, passed at December session, eigh-
