four thousand dollars, together with interest thereon, at the rate of six per cent, from the said twenty-seventh day of July, eighteen hundred and twelve.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty To be paid out of of the said Treasurer to redeem and pay the said stock, principal and interest, out of the proceeds and residue of the fund heretofore set apart by act of the present session, to indemnify the sufferers by riots in the city of Baltimore, in August last, and that the said fund shall be, and the same is hereby set apart and solemnly Pledged pledged for the redemption of said stock.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be city authorities lawful for the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, at any time, to provide by loan or by levy upon the assessable property of the city aforesaid, for the payment and redemption of the stock aforesaid; and upon Thereupon the fund restored the redemption thereof by the said city, within two years from and after the passage of this act, thereafter as heretofore, the said sum of twenty thousand dollars annually, shall be paid out of the proceeds of duties arising from sales at public auction, for the purpose of deepening and improving the harbour of the city of Baltimore, subject always to the control of the legislature of Maryland.

CHAPTER 227.

An act to authorise the Clerk of Prince George's county, Passed Mar, 25, 1836 to record a deed therein mentioned, and to make the same valid.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Record directed Maryland, That the clerk of Prince George's county court, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to record a deed from Frances P. Hamelton, of the State of Illinois, to Horatio C. Scott, of Prince George's county, in the State of Maryland.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That from and after the Made valid actual record of said deed, it shall be good and operative to convey the property, therein mentioned, according to the true intent and meaning of said deed.
