

CHAP. 251. mile, on all goods, merchandise, or property of any description whatsoever, transported on said rail road, or any lateral ways which they may construct, and also not exceeding two cents per mile, for each passenger transported on said rail road; *Provided, always,* that when any car shall be placed on said rail road, it be adapted in size and all necessary particulars to said rail roads; *and provided, further,* that the legislature of this State may at any time hereafter, regulate, modify or change the control, use and estate of so much of the rail road as shall be constructed under the authority hereby given, and be situate from Braddock's Run, through the gorge of the mountains, to the basin or the canal of the Chesapeake and Ohio canal company, at or near Cumberland, in such manner, as it may deem equitable towards the said company, and necessary to the accommodation of the public travel, or use of so much of the said rail road.

Open books for subscription

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the President and Directors of the said Maryland Mining Company, and William McMahan, John J. Hoffman and William Houx, shall be and they are hereby authorized to open books for subscription to the capital stock of a Bank, to be called the Mineral Bank of Maryland, to be located at Cumberland, in the county of Allegany, the capital stock whereof shall be five hundred thousand dollars, divided into five thousand shares of one hundred dollars each, which said books shall be opened in the town of Cumberland, and at such other places in this State or elsewhere, and under the direction of such persons, as they may appoint, and to be kept open for not less than two days, at each several place, having given notice for four weeks, in one or more newspapers published in the respective places where said books are to be opened.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That as soon as two thousand five hundred shares, shall have been subscribed, the proprietors of said shares, their successor, and assigns shall be and they are hereby created, made and declared to be a corporation and body politic by the name and style of the Mineral Bank of Maryland, and by that name shall be and are hereby made able
