### CHAPTER 275.

Passed Mar. 30, 1836 *An act to authorise the Levy Court of Kent county, to levy a sum of money on the assessable property of said county, to make a causeway, and erect a bridge on the public road leading from Millington to Smyrna, near and adjoining the Town of Millington.*

Justices to levy *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,*  
 That the justices of the levy court, of Kent county, be and they hereby are empowered, in their discretion, to levy a sum of money upon the assessable property of  
 Causeway said county, sufficient for the making a causeway and erecting a bridge on the public road leading from the town of Millington towards Smyrna, near the said town of Millington, to be built of such materials and of such construction, as they in their judgment may think best calculated to promote the public interest.

### CHAPTER 276.

Passed Mar 26, 1836 *An act to incorporate the Battle Creek Academy, in Calvert county.*

WHEREAS, application has been made to this General Assembly of Maryland, for the passage of a law to incorporate the Battle Creek Academy, in Calvert county:—Therefore,

Trustees **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That John J. Brook, John Broome, James Duke, Uriah Laveille, Joseph T. Wilson, Charles M. Frazier and John Mills, be and they are hereby appointed the first trustees of the said academy, and the said trustees and their successors to be elected in manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be and they are hereby established and declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, with perpetual succession
