ably distributed to, and amongst all the persons who shall be its creditors at such time, and to their assigns respectively.

SEC. 15. And be it enacted, That at any time here-issue of notes after, the notes or issues of this corporation, commonly called and known as bank notes, may be restricted by the Legislature, to a denomination not less than that of the notes or issues of any other incorporated bank within this State, the lowest denomination of whose notes, or issues shall be above five dollars.

SEC. 16. And be it enacted, That this State reserves Power of revocato itself the power of revoking this charter, if at any time said bank shall refuse or neglect to pay specie for any of its notes or bills.

## CHAPTER 299.

An act to authorise the building a Bridge over the west-Passed April 4,1836 ern branch of the Patapsco Falls, at Sykesville.

Whereas, it is represented to this General Assem-Preamble bly of Maryland, by the petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore and Anne Arundel counties, that they suffer great inconvenience for the want of a bridge over the western branch of the Patapsco Falls, at Sykesville:—Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Commissioners Maryland, That George Patterson, William Warfield, and John Hipsley, of Baltimore county, and James Sykes, Benjamin Hood, Senior, and Dr. R. D. Hewitt, of Anne Arundel counties, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and empowered, to con-to build bridge tract for, superintend and direct the building of a bridge over the western branch of the Patapsco Falls, Location at the most suitable point at Sykesville, so as to unite the public road of Anne Arundel with that of Baltimore county, which passes through Sykesville.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted. That it shall be the duty site of the commissioners herein before mentioned, or a majority of them, to examine and fix on the most suitable site for the erection of said bridge, and to ascertain
