CHAPTER 299.

An act to authorise the building a Bridge over the western branch of the Patapsco Falls, at Sykesville. Passed April 4, 1836

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly of Maryland, by the petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore and Anne Arundel counties, that they suffer great inconvenience for the want of a bridge over the western branch of the Patapsco Falls, at Sykesville:— Therefore, Preamble

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That George Patterson, William Warfield, and John Hipsley, of Baltimore county, and James Sykes, Benjamin Hood, Senior, and Dr. R. D. Hewitt, of Anne Arundel counties, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and empowered, to contract for, superintend and direct the building of a bridge over the western branch of the Patapsco Falls, at the most suitable point at Sykesville, so as to unite the public road of Anne Arundel with that of Baltimore county, which passes through Sykesville.
