

spective counties, to be collected as the county charges are usually collected and paid over, as may be directed by the said levy courts or county commissioners; *Provided*, that the said levy courts or county commissioners shall in no case exceed the sum of thirty dollars for any one year, in their allowance to any one person.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the said levy courts or county commissioners, may and they are hereby authorised, should the nature of the application in their opinion require immediate relief, to pay any amount not exceeding thirty dollars as aforesaid, from any unappropriated money in their hands, immediately upon such application to such applicant, or to such other person for their use as they the levy courts or county commissioners in their judgment may deem best.

Authority to pay immediately

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That nothing contained in this act shall be so construed to apply to Baltimore, Caroline, Queen Anns, Allegany, Cecil, Prince George's, Washington, Dorchester, Harford, Worcester, Anne Arundel, Calvert, Saint Mary's and Somerset counties.

Apply to certain counties

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That an act of assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter one hundred and fifty, entitled, an act relative to out pensions in Charles county, and all other acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, granting pensions by county assessment to indigent persons in Charles, Montgomery, Frederick, Talbot and Kent counties, be and the same are hereby repealed.
