

said committee so chosen, shall serve for one year, and until others shall be chosen and no longer.

CHAP. 309.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the service of legal process on any one of the committee shall be deemed a service of the same on the corporation.

Service of process

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall in any wise affect the rights of the legislature, to levy a tax upon the real and personal estate of said company, similar to any tax which may be imposed on other real and personal property within this State.

Power to tax

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this charter shall continue and be in force until the General Assembly shall deem it proper to annul the same and no longer.

Duration

CHAPTER 309.

*A supplement to an act to incorporate the Weverton Manufacturing Company, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter one hundred and forty-four.*

Passed April 2, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall and may be lawful for the stockholders of the Weverton Manufacturing Company, agreeably to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, to augment their capital stock, as they may find expedient and necessary, from time to time; *Provided*, that the said capital stock shall not exceed two millions of dollars.

Power to augment stock

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said company shall be allowed to purchase and hold lands in this State; *Provided*, that the quantity so purchased or held by them shall not in all exceed five thousand acres.

Power to hold land

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if any stockholder, subscriber or owner of capital stock in the said company, shall fail to pay the amount which may at any time be due upon his said stock, or any instalment thereof, at the time and place which shall be prescribed for the payment thereof, and for the space of sixty-days after the same shall be due and payable, agreeably to
