Proviso

this law, for Abraham Deaver, of Frederick county, to remove and bring into this State a negro woman, named Winny Johnson, which said negro woman said Deaver acquired by an exchange for another negro woman, with his son-in-law, Joseph Everhart, who is now removed to the State of Missouri; *provided* said Deaver shall comply with the provisions of the latter part of the fourth section of an act of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter three hundred and twenty-three.

CHAPTER 53.

Passed Feb. 18, 1836 *An act to locate a Public Landing at or near the head of the tide waters of the Great Falls of Gunpowder, in Baltimore county.*

Preamble

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly by the petition of sundry taxable inhabitants of Baltimore county, that a Public Landing at or near the head of the tide waters of the Great Falls of Gunpowder, in Baltimore county, would be of great convenience to the people of the vicinity,—Therefore:

Appointment of commissioners to locate

SECTION 1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of Baltimore county, be and they are hereby authorised to appoint three persons as commissioners, whose duty it shall be to locate a public landing at or near the head of the tide waters of the great falls of Gunpowder in Baltimore county, as in their judgment will be most eligible for the purposes of said landing.

Purchase lot

Appropriated

Limit of quality

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners appointed by the commissioners of Baltimore county, be authorised to purchase any lot of ground which they may select for said public landing, and upon such purchase the said lot of ground shall be forever considered, and used as a public landing; *provided* said lot of ground does not exceed one acre, or does not amount to a sum of money over one hundred dollars.
