

such other times as they by their ordinances or by their adjournments, may direct, and the said board of trustees shall elect from amongst their own number, a president, secretary and treasurer, in order that their business may be the more readily expedited, and all ordinances, rules and regulations passed by the said board, shall have affixed the signature of their president and countersigned by their secretary, they shall also be requested to keep a journal in which shall be carefully registered all their proceedings, and make an annual report of their acts, and the state and condition of the academy during their term of service.

CHAP. 323.

Election of officers

Journal to be kept

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the board of trustees shall have full power and authority to make contracts with the professors or teachers, relative to the instruction of the scholars to be placed under their care, and the payment of their salaries; to hear and determine upon all complaints and appeals, and other matters touching the discipline and government of the said academy; and generally to manage the state and concerns of the same in such manner as they shall deem best for its advantage; and any professor, teacher or assistant, against whom any charge or complaint shall be alleged, shall have the privilege to appear before the trustees and defend himself, the trustees first giving him notice in writing, setting forth the nature of the charge or complaint.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the said board of trustees and their successors, shall hold two public examinations, annually, at such time as may be agreed upon by the said board and professor, with a view to test the progress of the students of said academy, and to visit it regularly once a month, to ascertain the condition, discipline and management of the same.
