

the above price of one hundred dollars, then, that the sheriff of Baltimore county shall summon a jury to value said lot of ground which valuation shall be returned to the commissioners of Baltimore county, and if approved by them, and upon payment of said valuation to the owner or owners of said lot of ground, then the said lot of ground shall be condemned as a public landing.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners Road authorised appointed by the commissioners of the county as aforesaid to locate the public landing as herein before provided, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to lay out, locate and open a public road from said landing when the same shall have been located as aforesaid, to some convenient point on the nearest public or county road in the vicinity of said landing, so located as aforesaid, and the said commissioners shall make a return thereof to the county commissioners as is now required by the existing laws as regards the opening of public roads in said county, and the said commissioners shall be entitled to the same compensation Compensation for their services as commissioners are now allowed for similar services, when appointed by the county commissioners under the existing laws, to lay out and open county roads in said county.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners Levy authorised of Baltimore county are hereby authorised and required to levy upon the assessable property of said county, the sum of money necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this act; *provided* the amount for opening Limit said road shall not exceed one hundred dollars, and to pay or cause the same to be paid over to the party or parties that may be entitled to receive the same.
