CHAP. 331.

An act to authorise John Mactavish to act as trustee in the case therein mentioned, and to hold land as tenant by the courtesy. Passed April 2, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, John Mactavish, an alien resident, be, and he is hereby made capable at law, to exercise and fulfill in all particulars, the trust reposed in him as trustee, under the last will and testament of Charles Carroll, of Carrollton, as fully to all intents and purposes, as if he were a native citizen of the United States.* Authority to act

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That the said John Mactavish, be, and he is in like manner, made capable at law, to act as the executor of his wife Emily Mactavish, should he be appointed her executor by her last will and testament, and to exercise and fulfill in all particulars, such trusts as may be reposed in him, under the last will and testament of said Emily.* Authority to act as executor to his wife

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted, That the said John Mactavish, be, and he is hereby made capable at law, to take and hold as tenant by the courtesy, any real estate now held, or to be hereafter held by the said Emily Mactavish, his wife, as fully to all intents and purposes, as if the said John Mactavish were a native citizen of the United States; Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall have effect only so long as said Mactavish shall continue to reside in the United States.* To be tenant by courtesy
