make return of the inquisition so found to the clerk of his county, and such clerk shall file the same, and lay it before the county court at its next session, and such inquisition shall be confirmed by the court, unless good cause be shewn to the contrary; and when confirmed shall be recorded by the clerk at the expense of the company, but if set aside, the court shall direct another inquisition to be taken in the manner above prescribed, and after confirmation of any inquisition and payment or tender, to the owner of the property valued, of the sum awarded to them or their legal representatives, the property thus valued according to the interest and estate valued, shall vest in said company as fully, as if it had been conveyed by such owner or owners, and if the sum so awarded, be not received by the owner when tendered, or if he, she or they be absent, or have no legal representative in the county, such sum of money, but without interest or costs, may at any time thereafter be demanded and recovered from the company by the person or persons lawfully entitled to the same.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted,* That whenever in the construction of said road or roads, it shall be necessary to cross any established road or way, it shall be the duty of the president and directors of said company so to construct their said road across such established road, as not to impede the passage or transportation of persons or property along the same, and where it shall be necessary to pass through the land of any individual, it shall also be their duty to provide for such individual, proper wagon ways across such road, from one part of his land to another.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted,* That the said president and directors, or a majority of them, shall have power to purchase with the funds of said company, for use on their said roads, engines, machines, wagons, vehicles, cars, carriages and implements, such as they may deem necessary and convenient for transportation and other purposes on said roads, and shall have power to charge for tolls and for the transportation of persons and property of every kind on their said roads, any sum not exceeding the following rates, viz:—on
