person or persons upon the most economical terms to construct said bridge.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the commissioners Levy 8500 of Baltimore county, be and they hereby are authorised and directed at their next annual levy, to levy on the assesable property of said county, the sum of five Paid hundred dollars to be collected in like manner as other county charges, and paid to the order of said commissioners hereinbefore first named, or a majority of them, for the purposes of said Bridge, which, when completed shall be preserved and repaired in like manner as is directed by law in relation to other public bridges in said county.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That if any vacancy case of vacancy shall occur among the said commissioners first hereinbefor named, by death, resignation or otherwise, before the completion of said Bridge, the county commissioners shall have full power to supply such vacancy.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That when the said Bridge Final accountshall have been completed, the commissioners hereby appointed, or a majority of them, shall render to the commissioners of said county a fair and explicit state. ment of the sums expended in the crection of said Bridge, together with the vouchers for the same, and if any surplus shall then remain in their hands of the sum hereby appropriated, the same shall be paid over to the said county commissioners to be applied to the payment of the public charges of said county.

CHAPTER 59.

An act supplementary to an act, passed December session Passed Feb, 13,1836 eighteen hundred and thirty four, chapter one hundred and ninety five.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of commissioners aus Maryland, That the commissioners appointed by the tendroad act passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty four, to lay out and open a road from Philip Nicodemus' mill, in Frederick county, to a point near the bounding tree of the beginning of a tract of land
