Distribution directed

such sale, and shall under the direction of the said court, after deducting from the proceeds of said sale, all the costs and expenses thereof, and a reasonable and just sum for the county taxes and other reasonable expenses heretofore paid and borne by the said James Galbraith, for repairs, et cetera, to the said tract of land, make equal distribution of the residue of said purchase money among the several surviving relatives of the said Samuel Galbraith, deceased, in the manner now provided by law for the division and distribution of the personal estate of persons dying intestate in this State, whether such relatives shall be citizens of the United States, or aliens, whose respective receipts under seal, shall be a full release and acquittance to the said James Galbraith for their respective shares of the said residue.

Orphan's Court directed

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Orphan's Court of Cecil county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to take cognizance of said sale, and other the proceedings thereunder, required to be done before the said court by this act.

CHAPTER 379.

Passed May 27, 1836. *A further additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to Incorporate a company, for the purpose of cutting and making a Canal between the River Delaware, and the Chesapeake Bay.*

Authorised to fund their debts

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall and may be lawful for the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal Company to fund all the debts now due by said company to creditors, whose debts are secured or supposed to be so, by judgment or mortgages, or are evidenced by certificates issued by said company, or due in any other way, or for any cause or contract whatsoever, including the judgment obtained by John Randel, Junior, against the said company, in the superior Court of the State of Delaware, for two hundred and twenty-six thousand, eight hundred and eighty-five dollars, eighty-four cents, with lawful in-
