CHAP. 390.

An act for the relief Peter A. Carnes, of Baltimore County. Passed May 30, 1836

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Insolvent
That the commissioners of insolvent debtors for the city and county of Baltimore, be, and the same are hereby authorised and empowered, to grant to Peter A. Carnes of Baltimore county, the benefit of the several acts of Assembly, passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; *Provided*, the said Peter A. Carnes, shall in all respects, except that of proving residence comply with the requisitions of said acts of Assembly, and he satisfy the said commissioners that he did not come into this State with the view of obtaining the benefit of said insolvent laws.

CHAPTER 389.

A supplement to the act, entitled, an act to divorce Eliza Chavalier, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Nicholas W. Chavalier. Passed June 3, 1836

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the second section of the act, to which this is a supplement, be, and the same is hereby repealed. ^{2d sec. repealed}

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Nicholas W. Chavalier, be, and he is hereby declared to be entitled to the guardianship of his child or children, by his marriage with the said Eliza Chavalier. ^{Guardianship}
