Passed Feb, 4, 1836

Resolution in favour of Solomon Hillen, Junior.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to Solomon Hillen, Junior, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, the sum of twenty five dollars, for services rendered as one of a committee on the Library during the recess of the Legislature.

No. 10.

Passed February, 4, Resolution requiring the Armorer at Annapolis, to deliver certain Arms to Captain Tompkins, Lieutenant Taylor, Doctor Hawkens, and Lieutenant Walbach.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the armorer at Annapolis, be, and he is hereby required to deliver to Captain Tompkins, Lieutenant Taylor, Doctor Hawkens and Lieutenant Walbach, officers of the United States Army, each a pair of pistols with accoutrements on receipt given for the return of the same.

No. 11.

Passed February 4

Resolution in favour of Thomas F. Bowie.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas F. Bowie, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, the sum of one hundred and twenty-eight dollars and thirty-four cents, for expenses incurred and services rendered in arguing the case of the State vs. Thomas Bruce and his sureties, in the Court of Appeals of this State.
